**Numbering your ancestors using the Stradonitz System**  
 These charts use the Stradonitz System whereby the person whose ancestry is being traced is #1, his father #2 and mother #3. The father of any individual has a number double that of the individual and the mother has a number, double plus one. With the exception of the person under study, all males have even numbers and all females have odd numbers.
